

The cruise registration process changes starting with the 2018/2019 season is intended to provide adequate advance notice when registration will open. The 24-hour open window and subsequent lottery for slips, if necessary, gives everyone a fair opportunity to obtain a slip.

When registering, a \$25 per person nonrefundable registration fee will be charged for long cruises. The fee will be credited to the cruise costs. The fee will only be refunded if you are not offered a slip within 7 days of the cruise.

Everyone who registers must provide a check for the balance of the cruise cost by the date provided by the cruise leader to hold the slip or position on the wait list. Failure to do will cause you to move to the end of the cruise list.

The checks will not be cashed until the trip. Anyone who cancels will have their check returned subject to the following:

- The LYC has not incurred any significant costs due to the cancellation? IE: meals, transportation, event expenses, etc. Nominal expenses for cruise folders and water should not be considered. The cancellation decision should be communicated quickly to the cruise team to have time to react.

The cruise leaders communicate the cancellation to the Fleet Captain with their recommendation on reimbursement. The Fleet Captain can approve reimbursements up to 2 weeks prior to the cruise. Cancellations within 2 weeks will be approved by the LYC board.
